## Glenholme School Reporting on Achievement of Maori Students

Glenholme School, in consultation with our Maori parents and Whanau have a policy, plans and identified targets for improving achievement for Maori students.

### Aim of the Survey

- The Board of Trustees will take the opportunity to consult with our Maori Community about the achievement of Maori students at Glenholme School.

### Purpose of the Survey

- To involve the Maori community and Whanau in identifying the needs of the students.
- To monitor and improve the achievement of Maori students at Glenholme School.

2009 the Board of Trustees received 33 survey returns from a total of 144 Achievement of Maori Student Surveys that were sent to the whanau of our Glenholme School students. Board of Trustees would like to share the information gathered from the surveys with our Maori whanau community.

The Board of Trustees have been collating historical data regarding feedback from whanau on Maori Student Achievement for two years. The same survey was sent out to parents and whanau in 2008. From both surveys the responses have been collated and presented in graph format to demonstrate community opinions and understandings for the previous two years.

We invite parents to peruse the information and phone the school office if you would be interested in attending an evening hui to look at possible strategic directions regarding Maori student achievement at Glenholme School.
